
## About Life Insurance for Christians

The Anchor Cross logo incorporates three early Christian symbols, the anchor, cross and fish.

A word play in Greek - *ankura*, or anchor, resembling *en kurio*, or "in the Lord" - the anchor was an early and prevalent Christian symbol by which Christians secretly identified one other during the Roman persecution. The anchor's origin as a Christian symbol was rooted in Hebrews 6:19: "*We have this hope, a sure and steadfast anchor of the soul, a hope that enters the inner shrine behind the curtain [...]."* 

The fish, "ichthus" in Greek, was also an early Christian symbol. The Greek letters for "ichthus" form an acrostic for "Iēsous Christos, Theou Yios, Sōtēr," meaning "Jesus Christ, Son of God, Savior." Several centuries later, the cross became the most common Savior, and his saving death and resurrection. Whereupon, quite naturally, the cross
